It could also include a government-sponsored program such as the Peace Corp or any similar program sponsored by a private organization. The donor's desire and intent is to provide funds through any means possible that will benefit the poor, distressed and underprivileged. Such a purpose would be met in providing a scholarship to a student in a course of study who, upon graduation, would work with the underprivileged. The donor's intent and purpose would also be met in providing a scholarship to a student from an underprivileged home and environment.

NOTE: If a continuing student, you must include a reference letter from your faculty advisor and unoffical transcript that includes spring grades. If you will be a freshman, you must include a reference letter from your high school principal or a teacher and unofficial high school transcript. No handwritten applications will be accepted.
