**Who may be eligible for the Clergy Dependents Tuition Discount?** The Student has a parent who:

- Is ordained or holds a district license; **AND**
- Whose primary source of income is from the church or is bi-vocational, **AND**
- Serves with one of the following role codes in his or her district journal (please specify from the list below):
  - PAS (pastor)
  - PSV-FT (pastoral service - full-time)
  - PSV-PT (pastoral service - part-time)
  - CHP (chaplain)
  - DA (district assignment)
  - DS (district superintendent)
  - GA (general church assignment)
  - GS (general superintendent)

**Who is Eligible for the Missionary Dependents Tuition Discount?** The Student has a parent who:

- Is an employed missionary by Nazarene Global Missions

**Eligibility Requirements:**

1. Eligibility is subject to approval each year by the offices of University Mission & Ministry and Financial Aid, and is not confirmed until all required or requested documents have been received and approved. Applicants must re-apply and meet compliance with all federal, state and institutional policies.
2. Verification of ministers is conducted through district journal review. Missionaries must provide a letter of employment verification from Nazarene Global Missions.
3. The dependent student must complete the FAFSA, meet the Federal Financial Aid definition of Dependent as used on the FAFSA and therefore cannot be married, cannot have children, and must be age 24 or younger (the semester in which the dependent turns 25 is covered by the benefit). This will be verified before the discount is awarded.
4. The student must be a full-time student with a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester. Discounts are awarded up to two semesters per academic year and split equally between semesters.
5. Students are eligible to receive this award with a 2.0 cumulative GPA requirement.
