Who may be eligible for the Clergy Dependents Tuition Discount? The Student has a parent who:

Who is Eligible for the Missionary or Para-Church Leader Dependents Tuition Discount? The Student has a parent whose primary income is derived from being:

A career missionary through their local mission board.

A self supporting staff member in a Para-Church organization (e.g., YWAM, FCA, YL, CRU)

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- **1.** Applicants must provide a letter from the proper official, either the appropriate Local Church Governing Board Secretary, Missions Regional Director, or Reporting Supervisor.
- 2. Eligibility is subject to approval each year by the offices of University Mission & Ministry and Financial Aid, and is not confirmed until all required or requested documents have been received and approved. Applicants must re-apply and meet compliance with all federal, state and institutional policies.
- 3. The dependent student must complete the FAFSA, meet the Federal Financial Aid definition of Dependent as used on the FAFSA and therefore cannot be married, cannot have children, and must be age 24 or younger (the semester in which the dependent turns 25 is covered by the benefit). This will be verified before the discount is awarded.
- 4. The student must be a full-time student with a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester. Discounts are awarded up to two semesters per academic year and split equally between semesters.
- 5. Students are eligible to receive this award with a 2.0 cumulative GPA requirement.
